Grant Guidelines

The 100+ Women Pembroke Petawawa District (100+ Women PPD) of the Pembroke Petawawa District Community Foundation (PPDCF) will accept Grant Applications from organizations that meet our funding guidelines.

Eligibility and Grant Criteria:

- Grants are made only to organizations recognized by the Canada Revenue Agency as registered charities.
- Applicants must demonstrate fiscal responsibility and effective management.
- Organizations must be based in the Pembroke, Petawawa, and surrounding area and projects must **benefit** the **women and children** of Pembroke, Petawawa and surrounding area.
- The applicants must demonstrate a commitment to the project through meaningful contributions of their own human and/or financial resources.

Funding Restrictions:

The PPDCF and 100+ Women Pembroke Petawawa District will not support grants for the following:

- Ongoing core operations (e.g. permanent staff salaries)
- Fundraising events or campaigns
- Partisan political or religious activities
- Individuals
- Event Sponsorships
- Deficit reduction
- Equipment purchases for administrative purposes.
